

Safari Day Activity Plan

9 Wild Activities · Materials & Instructions

1 Decorate Safari Binoculars

MATERIALS

Cardboard binoculars, stickers, gems, oil pastels, glue, hole punch & string

STEPS

1. Color binoculars with oil pastels.
2. Add stickers and gems.
3. Punch holes, tie string to wear around neck.

2 Animals in Kinetic Sand

MATERIALS

Kinetic beach sand, plastic safari animals, bin or tray

STEPS

1. Spread sand in a bin.
2. Hide animals throughout.
3. Dig, build, and create safari scenes.

3 Safari Bead Bracelets

MATERIALS

Leaf beads, colorful clay beads, stretchy cord, scissors

STEPS

1. Cut cord to wrist size.
2. String leaf & clay beads in a pattern.
3. Tie off ends and trim.

4 Pipe Cleaner Beaded Snakes

MATERIALS

Pipe cleaners, pony beads, googly eyes, hot glue gun (adult use)

STEPS

1. Thread pony beads onto pipe cleaner.
2. Bend into a wiggly snake shape.
3. Adult hot-glues on googly eyes.

5 Model Magic Safari Animals

MATERIALS

Model Magic clay (assorted colors), markers, pipe cleaners, googly eyes

STEPS

1. Shape clay into a safari animal — lion, elephant, giraffe, zebra, and more.
2. Add pipe cleaners for legs, tails, or whiskers, and googly eyes for a face.
3. Draw on spots, stripes, or details with markers; set aside to air dry.

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6 Backyard Animal Hunt

MATERIALS

Plastic safari animals, safari animal poster or chart

STEPS

1. Hide animals around the yard.
2. Give each explorer an animal poster.
3. Find animals and match to the poster.

7 Snake Kabobs

MATERIALS

Wooden skewers, grapes, strawberries, candy googly eyes

STEPS

1. Thread grapes & strawberries onto a skewer.
2. Attach a candy googly eye near the top.
3. Snack time!

Adult supervision — sharp skewer points.

8 Ice Excavation Dig

MATERIALS

Muffin tin, plastic animals, water, salt, small mallets, warm water

STEPS

1. Freeze one animal per muffin cup overnight.
2. Pop out frozen animal pieces.
3. Tap with a mallet & sprinkle salt to excavate.

9 Safari Story Time

MATERIALS

Cozy blanket or shady spot, storybooks
